How should we make our prayer?

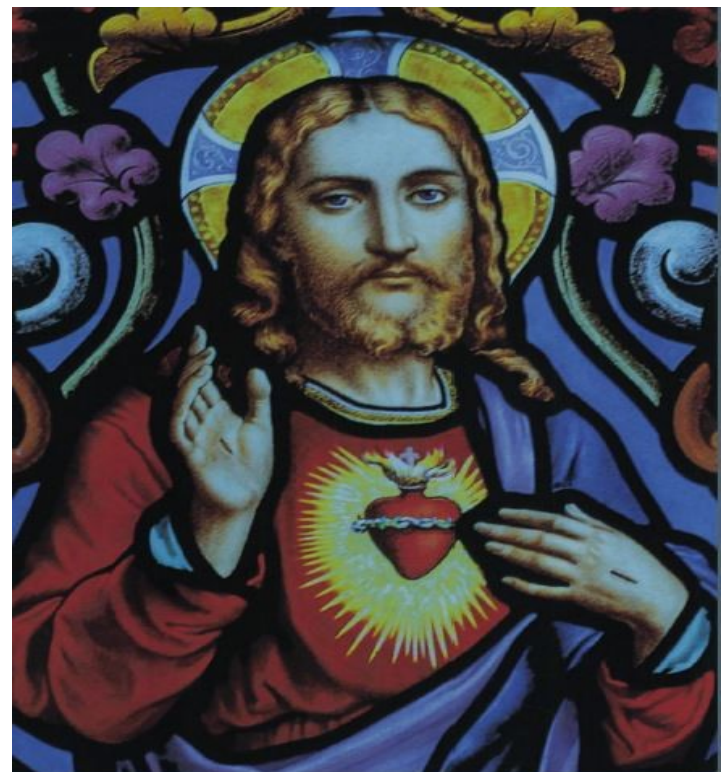
