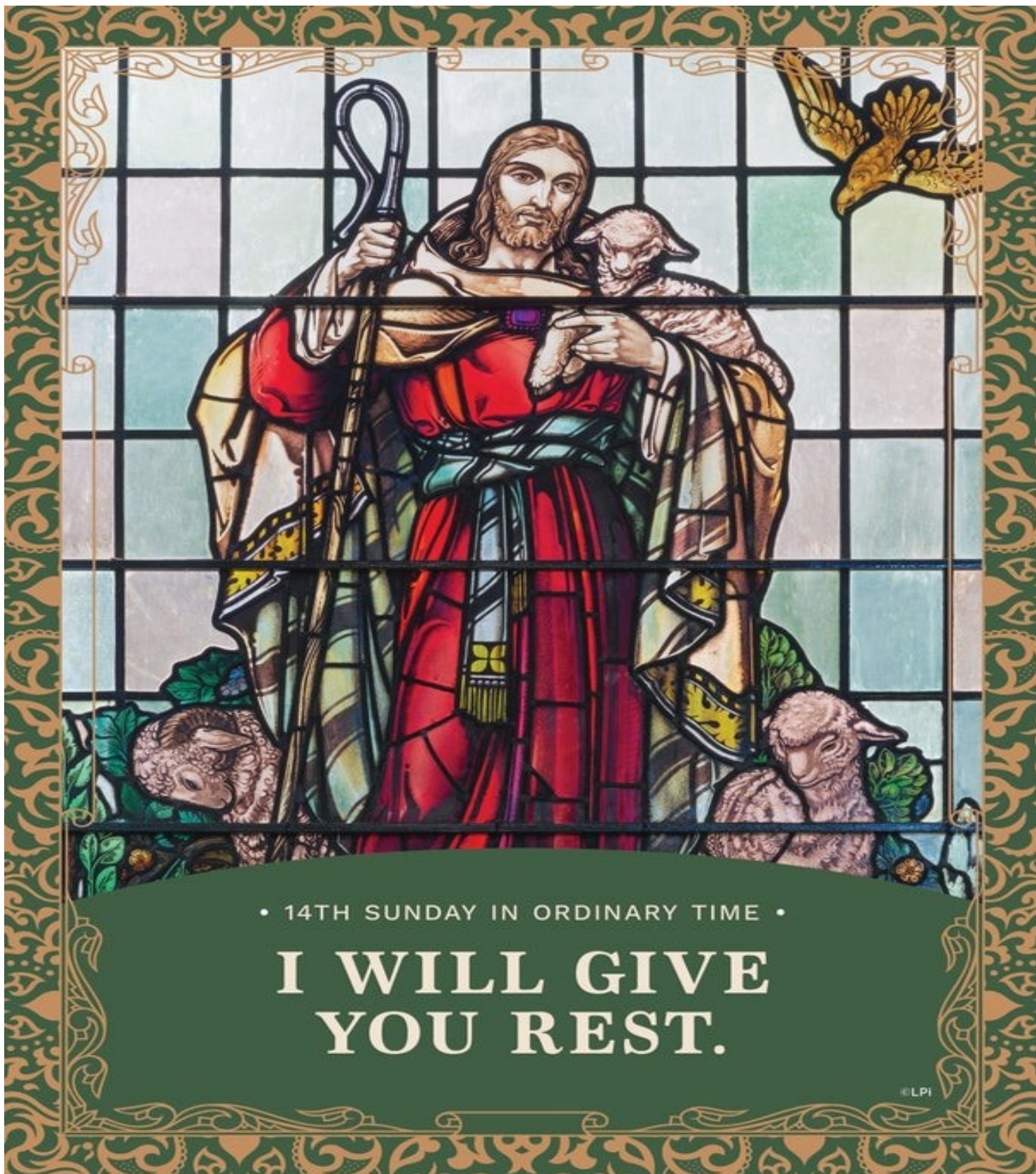

Baptism. Although the Church has practiced infant baptism for centuries, Vatican II shifted the theological stance of the sacrament. The Rite of Baptism for Children now being used emphasizes the role of the parents. When a child is baptized, the parents hand on a tradition and legacy they value. Before an infant is brought to baptism, the Church requires that the parents be suitably catechized, be active Catholics, and be instructed in the meaning of baptism and their responsibility as their child's primary religious educators.

We will be celebrating *First Saturday Mass* each month. Mass will be at **9:00AM**. Adoration and Confessions to follow until 10:00AM.

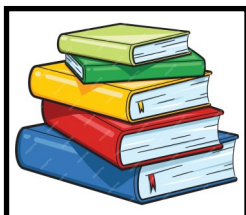
