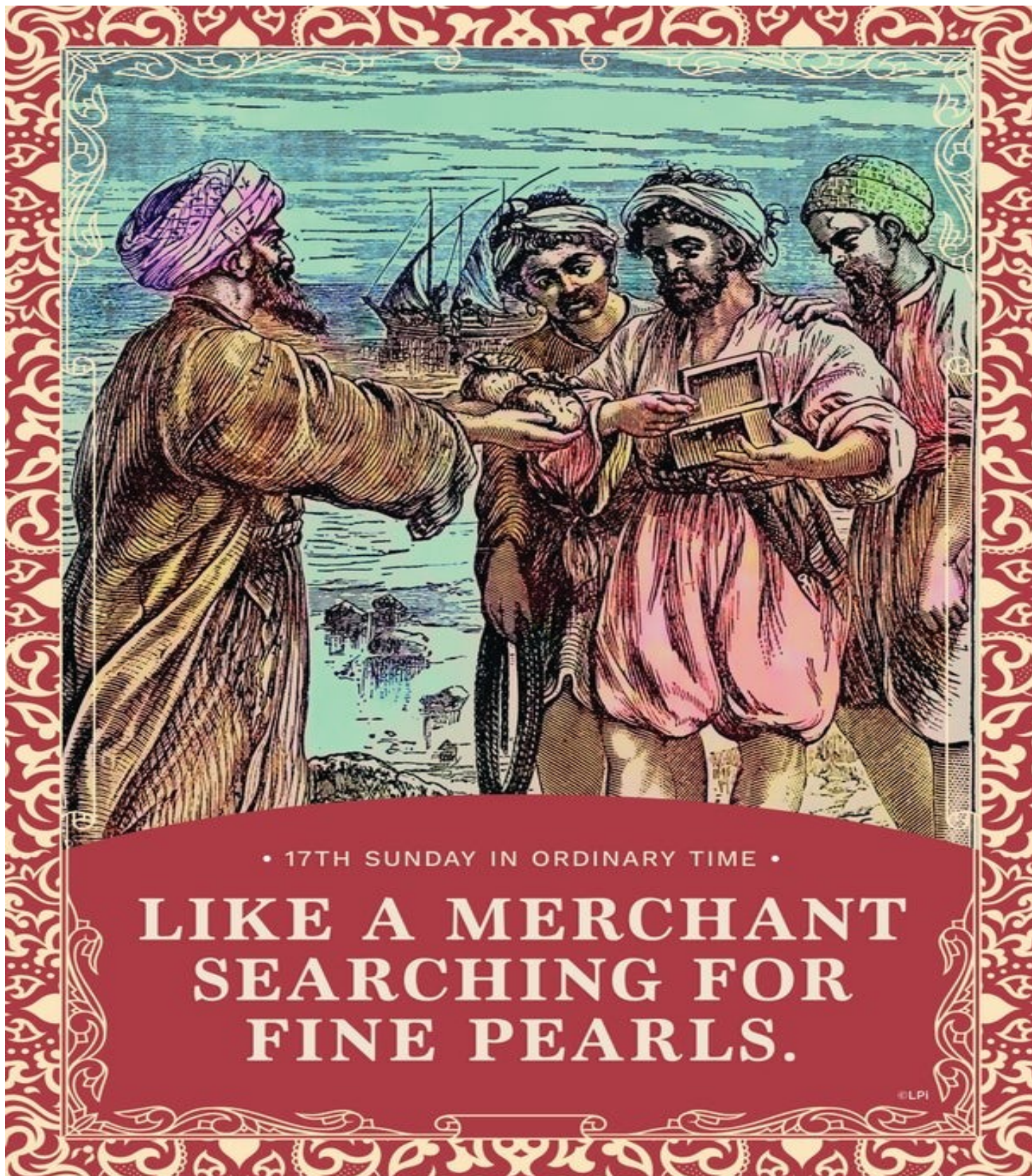

Principal Prayers**Pater Noster**

Why do we call God our Father?

Because He gives us natural life by creating and sustaining us in being, and gives us supernatural life by imparting grace to our souls and adopting us as His children.

Why do Christians say *our* Father, and not *my* Father?

To remind us that we: 1. Are brethren by being incorporated into Jesus Christ; 2. Ought to live in peace and unity; 3. Should pray for one another, as St. Cyprian explained: "The Teacher of peace and the Master of unity would not have prayer to be made singly and individually,...and when we pray, we pray not for one, but for the whole people, because we, the whole people, are one."

Why do we say: *Who art in heaven*?

Although God is everywhere, He is properly and especially in heaven, the place where He finally gathers His children together and manifests Himself to them in eternal joy.

What do we ask with the words: *Hallowed be Thy name*?

That the name of God, which is holy in itself, may be known, loved, and glorified by all men.
